The Research Station for Innovative and Global Tertiary English Education (IGTEE) has enjoyed another active year. The biggest highlight was co-organizing the Joint International Conference on ESP in Asia 2016 in August. This was the first time that this conference took place in Japan with approximately half of the participants attending from overseas. This conference provided numerous opportunities to establish and renew bonds of friendship in a network to promote ESP throughout the world. Besides this conference, we held four regular chapter meetings in May, July, November and January with presentations on the theme of English for Business Purposes (EBP). In September, we presented a poster about our chapter at the 55th JACET International Convention in Sapporo, and in March, we will publish Volume 18 of our Annual Report.
